Zhengzhou Yutong Bus Company is the largest bus manufacturer in China with ambitions to be one of the world's top five. The company, which sold 37,000 units in 2010, has developed international markets in Africa, South America and the Middle East.

Zhengzhou Nissan has been in operation since 2007, producing over 20,000 MPVs and SUVs per annum.

Zhengzhou is the centre of trade in Henan province and is an important commercial hub nationally.
